Message from Mrs Kay

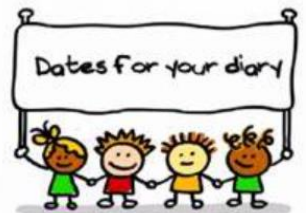

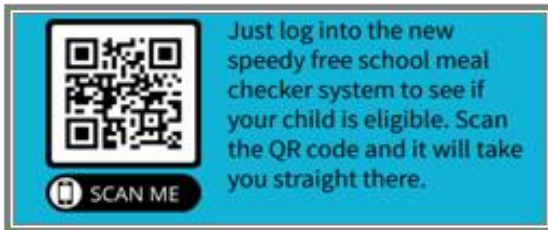
Class Dojo
