How can I help my child at home?

- Listen to them read at least 5 times per week and write it down in their reading diary.
- Allow them to read without stopping and only ask one or two questions each session.
- Encourage your child to read as much as possible wherever they are. It could be just as simple as reading the breakfast cereal box.
- Make sure your child brings their reading book and reading diary into school EVERYDAY.
- Provide a guiet and comfortable place for your child to practice their reading in.

Spelling Homework

• Ask your child what spelling pattern they are learning this week and have a go at some of these spelling exercises together. Your child may have brought some spelling homework home.

Spelling Rainbows

Rainbow write 8 of your spelling words. Write each word first in pencil. Then trace over each word 3 times. Each time you trace, you must use a **DIFFERENT** colour.



Choose 10 spelling words.

You are going to write them two times. Write them first in squiggly letters. Then write them once more in regular letters. Write neatly!

Bubble Letters

Write 6 of your spelling words in bubble letters. After your write your words in bubble letters, colour your words with a crayon or coloured pencil.

Three Times

Choose 8 spelling words. Write each spelling word 3 times. First, write each word in pencil. Second write each word in coloured pencil. Third, write each word in pen. You MUST write neatly!

Pyramid Writing

Pyramid write NINE of your spelling words. You must write neatly! *Example: home h
