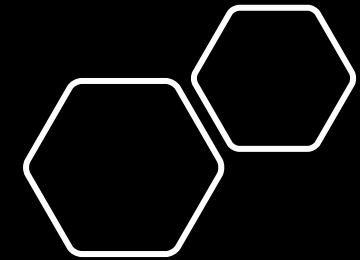

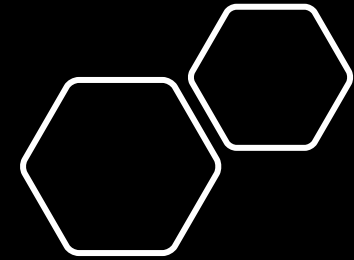

The children compete for their team in the annual sports day too.

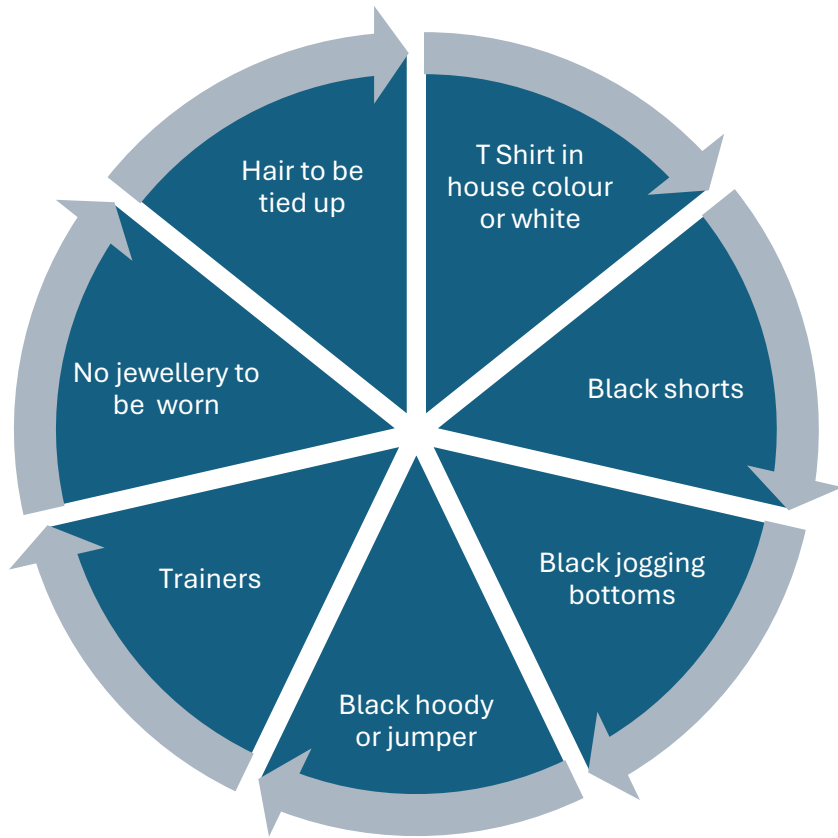

READING

Reading underpins everything we do in school.

Reading is used in every subject.

It is a really important life skill that we must work together on.



We expect children to read at home and reward this through the **Reading Rockstars Award**. Each class with the highest percentage of reads each week is awarded with the **Reading Owl for the week**.

Reading Certificates are also handed out each term to those children who have regularly read at home.

Maths – Times Tables Rockstars

As times tables form a huge basis for much of the Maths learning, we place a key emphasis on pupils having a firm knowledge of tables to 12×12 .

We develop this through the daily use of **Times Tables Rockstars** - weekly challenges where classes compete to win **Tommy and Timmy**, the Times Tables Turtles.

Children also receive half termly **Times Tables Tycoon** awards.

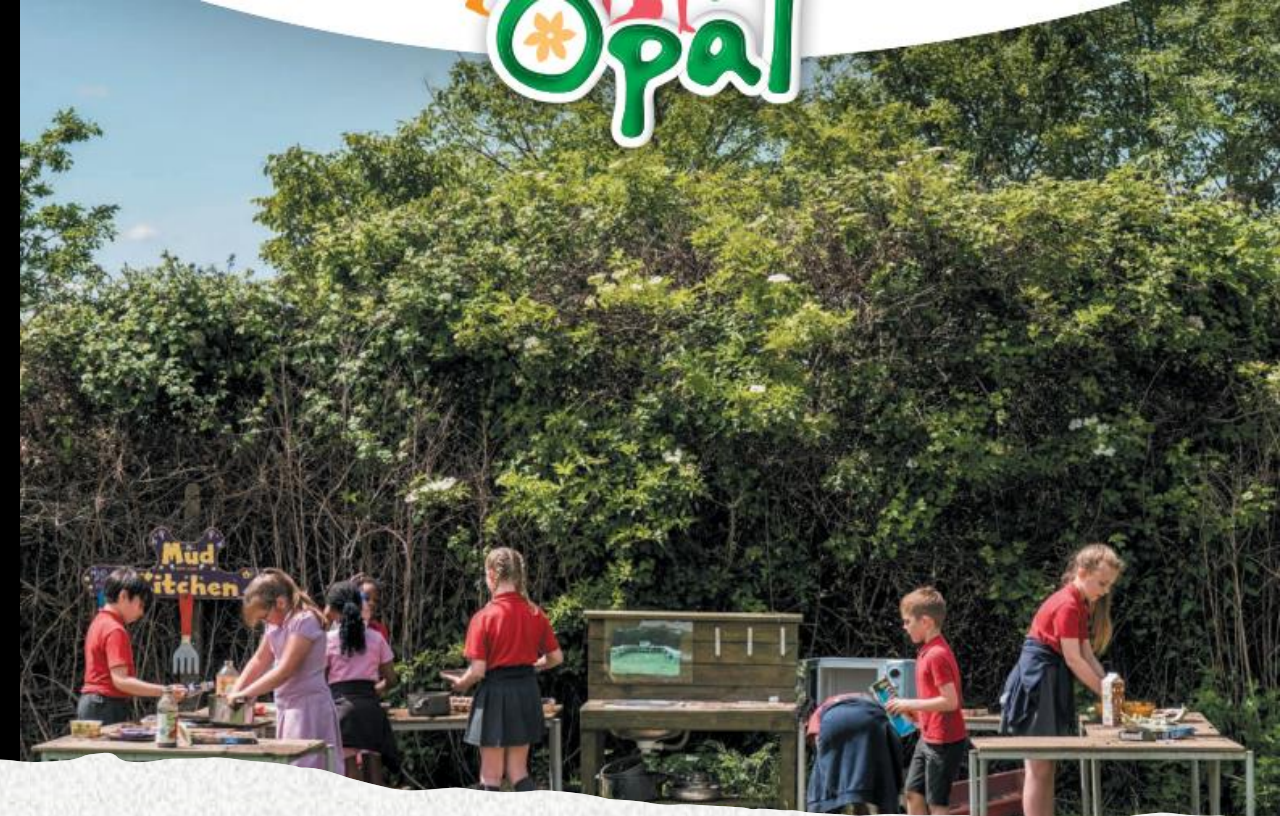
